To make it easy for guests to budget in advance of their trip, *Walt Disney World* has compiled a range of *Disney Dining Plans* that cover a wide range of dining experiences – from meals On-the-go, à la carte, fine dining, Disney Character experiences, and Dinner Shows too.

How do Disney Dining Plans work?

When guests are given their room key at check-in, which is also known as a 'Key to the World' card, points are added to the card automatically. When they purchase meals or snacks it electronically tracks each meal taken. Guests simply present their card to a Disney server before ordering. **Please note gratuities are not included in the Disney Dining Plans**, but they can be added to the 'Key to the World' card, so there is no need for them to carry any cash.

Are reservations needed?

Due to the popularity of Disney's Restaurants, availability may be limited without advance reservations. Guests can call **001 407-939-3463** to make any table service reservations up to 180 days prior to their visit. Reservations are accepted at most *Walt Disney World* Table Service restaurants, Signature Restaurants, Character Dining locations and Disney Dinner Shows.

What Disney Dining Plans are available?

Disney Quick (Counter) Service, Disney Dining Plan, Disney Deluxe Dining Plan and the *Disney Wine and Dine Plan*.

Dining Plan Table Service meals may be exchanged for other dining experiences such as a Character Dining Experiences with favourite Disney friends, Disney Signature Dining or Disney Dinner Shows.

What happens if guests don't eat at Disney for one day?

Meal points remain valid on your 'Key to the World' card for the duration of the stay, they do not have to be used each day. Unused points will expire when they check-out of their Disney Resort Hotel.

What are the benefits of purchasing one of the Disney Dining Plans?

Convenience: Guests can relax, knowing many of their holiday meals are paid for in advance.

Flexibility: They can select a dining plan which suits their holiday plans.

Ease: Points are loaded onto the 'Key to the World' card that they receive at check-in, and are redeemed at a wide range of restaurants throughout the Resort. The receipts show how many points are left.

Is there a Disney Dining Plan available for children?

All *Disney Dining Plans* are available for children aged 3-9 but they must order from a children's menu, where available. Many children's menus offer healthy options in addition to kids' favourites. The *Disney Dining Plans* are unavailable for guests under the age of 3, but they may share from an adult plate at no charge or purchase a meal from the menu.

It is often thought that only fast food is available at Walt Disney World, is that correct?

There are restaurants to suit every taste. *Walt Disney World* is aware of healthy eating, and many of the restaurants have a good selection of nutritious options including salads and fruit.

When your guests are busy enjoying the Disney Theme Parks, Quick (Counter) Service restaurants are perfect – just order at the counter from a range of tasty options such as sandwiches, salads, soups, hamburgers, pizza, pasta, grilled dishes and rotisserie chicken.

To keep your guests going between meals, they can choose from a range of soft drinks or light snacks such as popcorn, ice-cream or fruit to be found at various snack carts or Quick (Counter) Service restaurants throughout the Resort.

At Table Service restaurants guests can enjoy à la carte meals or they might opt for steaks, seafood, fish or international specialities – all brought straight to the table by friendly waiting staff.
